Six Places Where Yorkies Like To Be Scratched

Many dogs enjoy being pet, but a good scratch after a long day is at the top of your Yorkie's list of expressions of love and companionship. Of course, food is number one!

The moment this tiny ball of fur came into your life a strong bond began to form.

Our dogs bond with us physically, emotionally, and also chemically. This chemical bond occurs due to oxytocin, which is also known as the love hormone. This hormone increases in humans and dogs through affectionate interaction.

To your pup, this hormone explanation holds no meaning. To her - it just feels good!

No need to worry if you are scratching the right spot because she will let you know by offering yet another area to scratch. She may lean her back or rump on you, push her head under your hand, or roll over to expose her belly.

To help get things started, below are six areas I suggest you can try:

- 1. Belly and underside of the chest.
- 2. Top of the head just behind the ears.
- 3. Under the chin.
- 4. On the front of the neck.
- 5. On the side of the thighs.
- 6. Lower back near the base of the tail.
