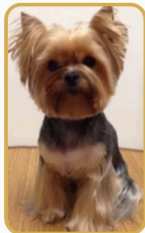

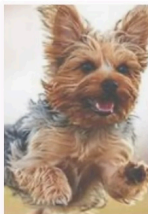

No Bake Pumpkin Dog Treats

For this recipe you will need a silicone paw print mold.
Makes 10 treats.

- 3/4 Cup of Coconut Oil
- 1/3 Cup 100% Pumpkin Puree
- 2 Tablespoons of Ground Ginger



1. Pour coconut oil and pumpkin in a sauce pan.
2. Heat on low until the coconut oil is fully melted and mixture takes on an orangish tint and absorbs some of the pumpkin flavor.
3. Place your silicone paw print mold on a flat surface. Put a pinch of ginger in each paw of the mold.
4. Spoon pumpkin mixture into each cavity, then proceed to gently spoon in the remaining oil to fill the cavities almost to the brim.
5. Place in the freezer for an hour or until solid. ENJOY!

Store any unused treats in an airtight container in the freezer.

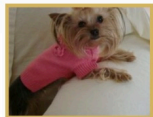

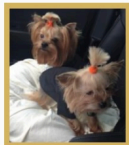


As we would say in my family..... she is a Quinceanera!

I got her littermate (Hannah) about a month later Annie arrived home so that she could have a playmate.



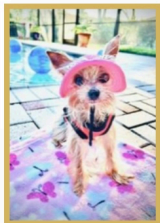
Unfortunately, Hannah passed away two years ago but Annie is hanging in there just fine.
